FROM THE CEPA FOUNDATION PERSPECTIVE:

- New organization with one of the objectives being to raise the Safety Bar!
- PCSR was already well established in Canada and doing some great work!

Why Bring in the Roundtable under the CEPA Foundation Umbrella.....?

From PCSR Perspective:

- OVERSIGHT- Solid Structure & Governance to get work done between roundtable gatherings!
- LEGITIMACY- Better visibility and access to other formal safety and regulatory bodies!
- STABILITY – Budget & Administrative certainty and access to web based infrastructure!

Process to make this happen.....

- ***Provided Governance Outline to both existing organizations..***
 - PCSR would be treated similar to any Foundation Project
 - Budget cycle would follow foundation cycle
 - Current PCSR members would not have to join the CEPA Foundation
 - CEPA Foundation would provide Administrative support
 - PCSR would set up a steering group to manage roundtables and any work projects that come out of the roundtable
- Developed a Roundtable Charter and provided an outline of Steering Group Team Roles and Responsibilities
 - Chair & Vice Chair roles were created to ensure sustainability

Things to consider.....

- INGAA Foundation has been in existence for over 20 years with a Safety/Quality Committee already established.....
- How will you manage those companies who currently participate in the US Roundtable but are not members of the INGAA Foundation.....
- Is there overlap between the Canadian PCSR and the U.S. PCSR?
